RHM SNAPSHOT REPORT FOR MAY PRESBYTERY OF MID-ATLANTIC

Jesus is powerfully on the march through His PMA church empowered by the Holy Spirit to further storm the gates of hell, to stomp the head of the serpent, and to further bind the strong man in establishing Gospel beachheads and outposts of heaven for worship, discipling, evangelism, and multiplication in church planting! Since the beginning of 2023, we have received Good Shepherd OPC (Eastern Shore, VA) as a mission work and are preparing to call a church planter-stated supply, Mr. Will Sloan, and two men are in training presently as potential officers. We are welcoming New Covenant (Abington, MD) into our presbytery from the PCA in May, Lord willing. We are seeking a church planter at our mission work at Word of Life in Howard Co., MD. We are thankful that our daughter church of Sterling OPC, Acacia Reformed, continues to thrive and is currently training officers to serve. We continue to serve the mission work at West Creek OPC (PSE) with RHM Lacy Andrews. We are thankful to be enjoying regular visitors at Acacia Reformed, and at Word of Life. We received 5 families into membership at Good Shepherd (Eastern Shore, VA), participated in 3 baptisms, and one adult male convert who recently came to Christ! (This is the second new convert to Christ that we know of in the PMA in the last year! Hallelujah!). Our presbytery hosted an Evangelism and Church Planting Conference with the goal of glorifying God, seeing sinners converted and saved, to inspire and encourage zeal in evangelism in our presbytery, and to see new churches planted. There were over 60+ folks in attendance from three presbyteries! (PMA, PSE, and PCPC). We are regularly reaching out with Gospel invitations at all of our mission works. Let us continue to be faithful and expectantly hopeful in our mission as presbytery to evangelize and plant churches through our prayers, ministries of word and sacrament, invitations, hospitality, reach out, etc.

Devotion/Meditation on Scripture: Let us remember that evangelism and church planting are storming the gates of hell and are further crushing the serpent's head in Christ. How? (Luke 10:17-20; Matthew 12:28-32; John 12:31-32; Revelation 12:10-11): "And they have conquered him [Dragon-Serpent-Lord] by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, for they loved not their lives even unto death" (Revelation 12:11). Note three important truths: 1) We are more than overcomers in Christ; 2) The word of our testimony is the Gospel that proclaims the blood of Christ that takes away our sins and restores us to God; 3) We overcome through self-denial, and successful, Spirit-filled evangelism and church planting always comes through self-denial.
