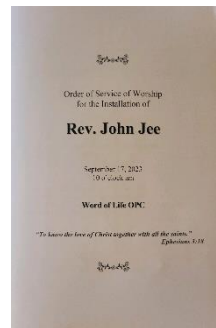
### Rejoice in the Installation of Rev. John Jee at Word of Life!
