






RHM Devotion: Wisdom Learned/Learning from 25 Years of Ordained Ministry

- 1) God is good and kind. Never, ever doubt this truth.
- 2) My family's and presbytery's and congregation's greatest need is my personal holiness.
- 3) It is not where you are, so much as what you become where you are. Goal: Growing in faith and patience.
- 4) Seek the LORD first, and make sure your priorities are daily aligned according to Scripture: Piety (Personal Holiness), Family, Church, Neighbors, etc. aka: Discern the difference between the important and the urgent.
- 5) Ministry is about Christ, not you. It is CHRIST'S CHURCH, not yours.
- 6) We must die daily if we are to be useful to the master.



- 7) Don't seek greatness except in being a great servant. Being a great servant is the greatest joy of a leader.
- 8) Remember true ministerial success is asking how you can be useful and faithful to the Master wherever and whenever He calls and directs you. He calls us to faithfulness, not results. We can expect fruitfulness, but we seek to be faithful for His glory! There is no failure in faithfulness.
- 9) Mind your duties (privileges of service!) to Christ, not your circumstances.
- 10) You must decrease; Christ must increase.
- 11) Seek to make it your spiritual goal to make others more spiritually successful than yourself.
- 12) You don't always have to be right, just listen. You don't always have to speak, just listen. Know when to speak and when to be silent.
- 13) Fear God and keep His commandments in reliance upon His grace. This is the only true cure for the terrible, enslaving, God-forsaking spiritual disease called "fear of man".
- 14) Be always cultivating humility, killing sin and pride, walking in repentance, and praying in the Holy Spirit.
- 15) Always be suspicious of your own heart, especially in communication and conflict.



Carnival on the Eastern Shore in Virginia. All the members of the congregation at GSOPC as well as "Biggs Team RHM" participated in the outreach.




There were close to 100 people spoken with either through invitation cards and tracts being given or



2024 Update on Good Shepherd OPC

Good Shepherd OPC began as an exploratory Bible study of the Presbytery of the Mid Atlantic in the summer of 2022. The group that our Risen-Ascended-Enthroned Lord brought together initially introduced us to Pastor Will Sloan who

was at that time a pastor in the United Methodist Church. As the bible study showed much progress in grace and unity quickly, and we had a man who was willing and able to shepherd the congregation, who was already greatly loved by the congregation, the RHM and Home Missions Committee thought it good to move forward to worship services as a mission work.



Good Shepherd OPC began worship services as a mission work in the late Autumn of 2022 with four

families, along with two or three other families inquiring and interested in the work who were attending some of the studies and services. The original provisional session that was formed was made up of Regional Home Missionary Charles Biggs, Elder Dan Cooke (PSE), Home Missions Chairman Andrew Miller, and Pastor Gerry Taylor. After Andrew Miller received his call to be the RHM in the Presbytery of Central Pennsylvania, we were thankful to have Pastor Francis Vandelden join us. As we began worship services, Elder Dan and your RHM would come and conduct worship services as often as we could

travel. The group was growing and joyous in Christ.

Pastor Will Sloan began his working toward licensure and ordination in the Orthodox Presbyterian Church in late 2022 and then throughout 2023. During this time, Elder Dan and I conducted officer training classes with two men who were interested in considering the ordained office and had already been demonstrating some spiritual gifts of shepherding and leadership for the congregation. Pastor Will successfully completed his licensure exams in Spring 2023 and was licensed to the gospel ministry by the PMA. He completed his ordination exams at the December 2023 meeting of the PMA and was unanimously received as an ordained

minister of the OPC. Between the Spring 2023 and December 2023, Pastor Will faithfully served the PMA as Stated Supply. He gladly and joyfully accepted the call to be the organizing pastor/church planter at our PMA December

2023 meeting. His ordination and installation date was in late January 2024.



Pastor Will was ordained and installed in January 2024 and has faithfully and eagerly shepherded the congregation since. Pastor Will and his wife Lauren, and their two daughters Isabel and Mary, have been strong and trusting in Christ through very difficult trials. They have served faithfully and exuberantly with joy in the Holy Spirit in this small flock. As your RHM, I was privileged to regularly come alongside Pastor Will and family as a pastor-mentor, and I have been very thankful to see a brother who is a humble and learned man, who is passionate about Christ and

making Him known. Pastor Will and his family have gone joyfully through trials, committed to Christ and His Church, and during this time, I have witnessed the Lord's working in Pastor Will. I have seen a young (er) man, new to the OPC, shepherd the flock faithfully that Christ has granted him. Though the flock of Jesus at Good Shepherd has been small, Pastor Will has demonstrated faithfulness to Jesus in the "small things" that are big things in our Lord's eyes.

Pastor Will has demonstrated faithfulness in preaching God's Word, administering the sacraments, praying with, and discipling the flock, and has engaged in eager and earnest outreach and invitations to his community on the Eastern Shore. We are grateful to our Sovereign and compassionate God who brought salvation to a brother under Pastor Will's discipleship, and we rejoice he was baptized in the Triune Name in the Spring of 2023! We are grateful that the two families entrusted to us at Good Shepherd have grown in God's grace, but we have not grown in numbers.



It is with heavy hearts that in our Lord's good and wise, yet mysterious providence, the congregation has not grown, and in fact, just a week prior to Will's ordination, two of the families decided to leave. Our Lord is faithful, and though we serve for God's glory and seek to be as fruitful as possible, only our God in Christ by His Spirit produces fruit and results. We are called to be faithful! We earnestly seek the "Well



done, good and faithful servants" from our Risen-Ascended-Enthroned Savior, Bridegroom, Elder Brother, Head of, and Shepherd of His Church. Pastor Will and the provisional session along with the Home Missions Committee have sought to be faithful through Word, Worship and Witness. However, God has not at this time brought the increase.

Last Spring 2024, when there did not seem to be any growth, though there was faithfulness, and there was a earnest reaching out and inviting neighbors and community, the provisional session along with the Home Mission Committee sought more objectivity from the Lord as to whether we should continue this work into 2025.

In an effort to be good stewards of God's resources, and especially for Pastor Will to be free to seek another call to pastoral ministry, we decided together that if there were not at least 5 new families by August 31, 2024, then we would consider concluding the work. We have concluded that what seems best to the Holy Spirit and to us, is that we should allow Pastor Will to seek a calling, to continue to shepherd the two beloved families at Good Shepherd, and to conclude this beloved mission work on December 31, 2024.

Please pray that as Pastor Will and family seeks God's guidance and direction, that our faithful God will provide and lead them to a place where they can use their gifts and bless Christ's Church! Please pray for the two families who love their pastor very much, that they will find a place where they may transfer their membership and to grow under another faithful shepherd of Christ's flock. Pray for the seed that has been planted through Word, Worship and Witness on the Eastern Shore through this faithful ministry at Good Shepherd. There is no failure in faithfulness. God's Word will never return empty or void but will always accomplish His purposes and will succeed in the thing for which He sends it (Isaiah 55:10-11).



He also serves as the Director of Evangelism for the Boardwalk Chapel in Wildwood, NJ, a ministry that trains over 300 youth and adults every summer in evangelism and apologetics. 
Berryville Bible Study Summer Outreach

Our outreach last night in Berryville had a great turnout (about 15). Though we felt weak






on His goodness and power, we generously gave out many gospel tracts, invitations to our bible study, cold water, and shared the gospel and prayed with quite a number of folks.


