

About the speakers...

Dr. Peter Lee is Professor of Old Testament and Dean of Students at Reformed Theological Seminary, Washington, D. C. He completed his MA and PhD at the Catholic University of America and his MDiv at Westminster Seminary in California. He is the author of Joy Unspeakable, and Aramaic Poetry in Qumran, as well as a contributor for A Biblical-Theological Introduction to the Old Testament: GospelPromised (edited by Miles Van Pelt), and several other articles in academic and ministry journals. Peter is also an ordained minister in the Orthodox Presbyterian Church and served as a church planter for Living Hope OPC in Clarksville, MD and Word of Life OPC in Columbia, MD. He has also served on the Home Missions committee for the Presbytery of the Mid-Atlantic for several years and participated as provisional session member for several mission works. He is married to Clara, and the Lord has blessed them with six children: Caleb, Jeremiah, Kara, Micah, Tabitha, and Priscilla

Rev. Chris Byrd served as Evangelist at Grace Presbyterian Church in Westfield, NJ from 2020-2024, and is now preparing to serve in a new role as Regional Home Evangelist for the Presbytery of New Jersey. He also serves as the Director of Evangelism for the Boardwalk Chapel in Wildwood, NJ, a ministry that trains over 300 youth and adults every summer in evangelism and apologetics. Chris also serves on the board of the Africa Christian Training Institute and has been leading Schools of Evangelism in Uganda since 2020. He received his M.Div from Westminster Theological Seminary in 2018. One of his greatest burdens is to see the church becoming truly "Great Commissional" and to see evangelism becoming part of the DNA of every Christian.
