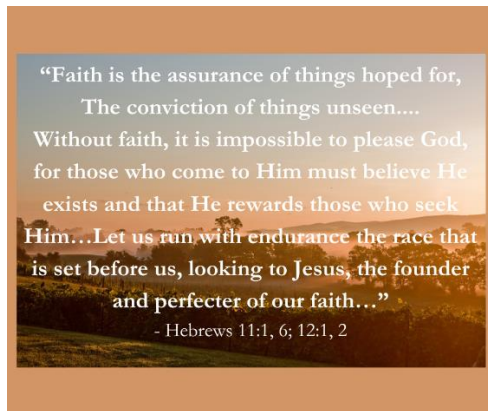

Article: *What does a Regional Home Missionary do?* Sometimes I’m asked the question, “*What does a Regional Home Missionary do?*” Here are a few important things I am privileged to do as your Regional Home Missionary in the PMA:

PRAYING- Persistent and Expectant Prayer in union with Jesus Christ by His Spirit is most important! Praying for the Lord of the Harvest to raise up faithful laborers and organize seed/core groups to harvest with joy those whom God has called to Himself. (John 4:34-38). Praying for and with those meeting together to become flourishing, gospel-oriented, self-sustaining, self-governing, self-aware Orthodox Presbyterian confessional congregations who are part of a region of connected churches and a larger denomination (Matt. 7:7; John 14:12-14).

SERVING- I am first of all a privileged servant of Christ and His Church. To serve the OPC PMA CHMCE in carrying out the mission of the triune God, the OPC generally, and the PMA particularly. I’m grateful regularly to serve organized congregations and mission works within our presbytery. Our mission statement as RHM/Home Missions in the PMA is on card.



PROCLAIMING/PREACHING/EVANGELIZING- Gratefully preaching God’s Gospel-Word to the saints and to the lost. I am privileged to edify and admonish the saints and call sinners to repentance and faith in Christ alone. Representing our OPC denomination and presbytery as an ordained Evangelist-Ambassador sent in the power of the Holy Spirit to plant churches, seek the lost, and to disciple/teach the saints (2 Cor. 5:14-21).

CONNECTING- Connecting with new folks who are seeking to be a new Orthodox Presbyterian congregation, thinking about joining the OPC, etc. What a glorious privilege to be an ambassador in this work.
